

NOTICE OF POSTAL BALLOT / E-VOTING

Pursuant to Section 110 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 22 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014

Dear Shareholders,

Notice is hereby given that pursuant to the provisions of the Section 108, Section 110 and other applicable provisions, if any of the Companies Act, 2013 read with rule 20 and rule 22 of the Companies (Management & Administration) Rules, 2014 (including any statutory amendment(s), modification(s), variation(s) or re-enactment(s) thereto, for the time being in force), in accordance with the guidelines issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs ("MCA") for holding general meetings/ conducting the process of postal ballot through remote e-Voting vide General Circulars issued by MCA ("MCA Circulars") from time to time, the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 ("Listing Regulations"), Secretarial Standard – 2 on General Meetings (the "SS-2") issued by the Institute of Company Secretaries of India and as amended from time to time any statutory modification or re-enactment thereto, and other applicable laws and regulations, if any, for the time being in force, to transact the Special Business, as set out in this notice as the Special Resolutions is proposed to be passed by the Members of KOHINOOR FOODS LIMITED ("The Company") by way of postal ballot only through voting by electronic means ("remote e-Voting").

According to Section 180(1) (a) of the Companies Act, 2013, sale, lease or otherwise disposal of the whole or substantially the whole of an undertaking of the Company or where the Company owns more than one undertaking, of the whole or substantially the whole of any such undertaking, requires the approval of the shareholders by way of a special resolution.

The proposed resolutions and explanatory statements pertaining to the said resolutions, pursuant to sections 102 and 110 of the Companies Act, 2013 setting out the material facts concerning each item and the reason thereof is appended herewith for your consideration.

As permitted under the MCA Circulars, the Company is sending the Notice in electronic form only. Hence, hard copy of Postal Ballot Notice along with Postal Ballot Form and pre-paid business reply envelope (BRE) will not be sent to the shareholders for this Postal Ballot and shareholders are required to communicate their assent or dissent through the remote e-voting facility. In compliance with Regulation 44 of the Listing Regulations and pursuant to the provisions of Sections 108 and 110 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with the rules framed thereunder and the MCA Circulars, the Company has extended only the remote e-voting facility for its shareholders, to enable them to cast their votes electronically instead of submitting the Postal Ballot Form. The instructions for remote e-voting are appended to the Notice. The shareholders can vote on the resolutions through remote e-voting facility. Assent (FOR) or dissent (AGAINST) of the shareholders of the resolutions mentioned in the Notice would only be taken through the remote e-voting system as per the MCA circulars.

The Company has engaged the services of National Securities Depository Limited ("NSDL") to provide the e-voting facility. Accordingly, members shall have to cast their vote electronically through the NSDL e-voting platform. Instructions on E-voting are enumerated as part of the Notice.

E-voting facility is available at the link <https://www.evoting.nsdl.com/> from Sunday, 23rd March, 2025, 9.00 a.m. (IST) onwards to Monday, 21st April, 2025, 5.00 p.m. (IST). Shareholders are requested to read carefully the e-voting instructions given in the Notes forming part of the Postal Ballot Notice, before logging into the e-voting link.

The Board of Directors of the Company, at its meeting held on Friday, 14th February, 2025 has appointed Mr. Manish Kumar, Proprietor of M/s. Mank & Associates, Company Secretaries (M. No. F 10248), as the Scrutinizer for conducting the Postal Ballot (only through Remote E-voting process) in a fair and transparent manner. The Scrutinizer, after completion of scrutiny, will submit his report to the Chairman of the Company. Thereafter, the results of the Postal Ballot would be announced by the Chairman of the Company on Wednesday, 23rd April, 2025 at the Company's registered office. In addition to the results being communicated to BSE Limited (BSE) and National Stock Exchange of India Limited (NSE), the results along with Scrutinizer's report will also be placed on Company's website viz. www.kohinoorfoods.in and shall also be available at the Company's registered office.

1. The Explanatory Statement pursuant to Sections 102 and 110 of the Companies Act, 2013 stating all material facts and the reasons for the proposals is annexed herewith.
2. The Board of Directors of the Company (“the Board”) at its meeting held on 14th February, 2025 has appointed Mr. Manish Kumar, Proprietor of M/s. Mank & Associates, Company Secretaries (M. No. F 10248), Company Secretaries to act as “The Scrutinizer” for conducting the Postal Ballot by way of remote e-voting process in accordance with the Act and in a fair and transparent manner.
3. The Postal Ballot Notice is being sent to Members in electronic form to the email addresses registered with their Depository Participants (in case of electronic shareholding)/the Company’s Registrar and Share Transfer Agents (in case of physical shareholding) and whose name appears on the Register of Members/ List of Beneficial Owners on 21st February, 2025. The Postal Ballot Notice will also be available on the Company’s website at www.kohinoorfoods.in.
4. On account of the threat posed by COVID-19 and in terms of the MCA Circulars, the Company will send this postal notice in electronic form only. The hard copy of this Postal ballot notice along with postal ballot forms and pre-paid business envelope will not be sent to the members for the postal ballot in accordance with the requirements specified under the MCA Circulars. Accordingly, the communication of the assent or dissent of the members would take place through the remote e-voting system only.
5. The voting period begins on Sunday, 23rd March, 2025, 09.00 a.m. (IST) onwards to Monday, 21st April, 2025, 05.00 p.m. (IST). During this period, shareholders of the Company, holding shares either in physical form or in dematerialised form as on the cut-off date of 21st February, 2025, may cast their vote electronically. Once vote on a resolution is cast by the member, he/ she shall not be allowed to change it subsequently or cast the vote again.
6. In compliance with provisions of Section 108 of the Companies Act, 2013, read with Rule 20 of the Companies (Management & Administration) Rules, 2014, the Company is pleased to provide its members the facility to exercise their right to vote by electronic means as an alternate mechanism. For this purpose, the Company has entered into an agreement with National Securities Depository Limited (NSDL) for facilitating e-voting in order to enable the members to cast their votes electronically instead of dispatching postal ballot form.

15. PROCEDURE/INSTRUCTIONS FOR REMOTE E-VOTING:

How do I vote electronically using NSDL e-Voting system?

The way to vote electronically on NSDL e-Voting system consists of “Two Steps” which are mentioned below:

Step 1: Access to NSDL e-Voting system

How to Log-in to NSDL e-Voting website?

3. Now you are ready for e-Voting as the Voting page opens.
4. Cast your vote by selecting appropriate options i.e. assent or dissent, verify/modify the number of shares for which you wish to cast your vote and click on "Submit" and also "Confirm" when prompted.
5. Upon confirmation, the message "Vote cast successfully" will be displayed.
6. You can also take the printout of the votes cast by you by clicking on the print option on the confirmation page.
7. Once you confirm your vote on the resolution, you will not be allowed to modify your vote.

ITEM NO. 1: APPROVAL TO SELL OF RICE FACTORY AT 'MURTHAL, HARYANA' OF THE COMPANY ON SLUMP SALE BASIS

Your Company had been declared NPA by the Banks in the Month of May-June 2018 and the Lead Bankers had already filed a petition under section 7 of IBC Act, before the Hon'ble NCLT Chandigarh due to financial crisis. Your Board has placed its extreme effort to revive the company from the current situation in the current scenario and ongoing pandemic and has placed its proposal of One Time Settlement (OTS) with the Banks. The settlement proposal includes the sale of selected assets/investment of the Company. The net proceeds from the sale of the Undertaking will be utilized towards the sanctioned One Time Settlement proposal with the Banks.

The Bank in its consortium meeting have agreed to the one time settlement proposal and the Board decided to sell the it's following Assets in the overall best interest of all the stakeholders. The Board of Directors of the Company, at its meeting held on 24th March, 2022 has approved the decision to sell / transfer/ dispose off its Rice

Factory situated at Murthal, Haryana, and the same was approved by the members of the company by special resolution through postal ballot held on April 29 2022. RCM CONSUMER PRODUCTS PRIVATE LIMITED at a value of INR 190 Crores, towards its consideration, on such terms and conditions as may be deemed fit by the Board, of its following undertaking:

Karnal Road, Murthal, Sonpath, Haryana-131027 India together with all specified tangible and intangible assets, including land in relation to the Factory but excluding its brand name, as a going concern / on a slump sale basis on an “as is where is” basis to M/s. RCM CONSUMER PRODUCTS PRIVATE LIMITED at a value of INR 190 Crores, towards its consideration.
